Granada and its surroundings - the last bastion of the Moors

The dynasty of the Nasrids (1238 - 1492) led the kingdom of Granada to a late flowering, at a time when the rest of Spain was back again in Christian hands. The most precious legacy of the Nasrids is the Alhambra Palace - a spectacular highlight of Islamic architecture. And, of course, a worthwhile place for the MMIG46 to visit.



Our exquisite Hotel, the *Barceló La Bobadilla* is something very special among the "white villages", located near Loja. Originally a finca and located on a 350 hectare estate, it has been carefully converted into a 5-star hotel.



Olives are obviously the agricultural mainstay in Andalusia. Indeed, some 80% of Spain's olive oil comes from the region.



El Torcal - in the region there's also a fantastic rocky landscape, created by erosion, with impressive karst formations.

Here there are also short one-hour walks around the area.
