Rundblättriger Sonnentau (*Drosera rotundifolia*)

Der Rundblättrige Sonnentau wird bis 20 cm groß und kommt vorwiegend in den Zwischen- und Hochmooren an Grabenrändern in den Torfmoospolstern, an quellighumosen Stellen auf Torf vor. Diese Arten sind im ganzen Bundesgebiet geschützt (Gefährdungsstufe 3).

Der Rundblättrige Sonnentau besitzt Drüsenhaare an denen Insekten kleben bleiben. Mit Hilfe eines Sekretes werden diese zersetzt und somit der Pflanze Stickstoff zugeführt. Die von den Drüsenhaaren ausgeschiedenen Sekrettröpfchen (volkstümlich „Tau“) geben ihm seinen Namen.

In Mecklenburg wurde der Sonnentau auch als Aphrodisiacum bei Haustieren angewendet und als „Bullkrut“ bezeichnet. Die Gattung *Drosera* ist mit 84 Arten über den größten Teil der Erde verbreitet.
