
## Review

This was, however, in the restaurant and, as usual, with the appropriate menu, which allowed you to make your own selection.




On 3.6.22 we went to Portoferraio, the island's capital.




We enjoyed our guide's extensive explanations.



The participants en route in Portoferraio.










We were heading for an exclusive city tour at the Medici fortresses and

There were a few things to be discovered in the old town of Portoferraio.






Forte Falcone, a coastal fortress built between the 16th and 18th centuries. Forte Falcone is, beside Forte Stella and Torre della Linguella, one of the three "pillars" of Portoferraio's defense system.

But first something to drink!




Here everything is made by the family themselves - wine, olive oil, cereals, vegetables and, of course, superb food!

Some bought wine to take home with them.




Around 3:30 p.m. we went back by bus to our Hotel Hermitage, with one last look at poppies, herbs and olive trees.




Then at 8:00 p.m. dinner at the hotel.
