## Postponement of the Mougins Fly-In!

From Thursday, $\mathbf{2 6}^{\text {th }}$ May (Ascension Day) to Sunday, 29 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ May 2022


Dear Members,
On $13^{\text {th }}$ January 2021 I received an e-mail from one member asking whether our Fly-In to Mougins shouldn't be postponed for another year until 2022 in view of the current situation.

Following the emergence of highly infectious mutations in the UK and South Africa which have in the meantime reached Germany - together with the limited supplies of vaccines - most of our members will probably not have been vaccinated by the planned dates of our Fly-In from $3^{\text {rd }}$ to $6^{\text {th }}$ June, 2021.

In addition to this, there is the possibility that our Hotel "Le Mas Candille" will still be closed as the Côte d'Azur is currently still a Covid-19 hotspot in France.

Having spoken to a number of our members, it is clear that people were greatly looking forward to this event, but where is the fun in being there if we have to wear masks and socially distance?

We are able to cancel the Fly-In without incurring any charges and can reschedule the event to Thursday, 26 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ May (Ascension Day) Sunday, 29 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ May 2022.

The room list has been confirmed by the Hotel so that participants will occupy exactly the same rooms that they would have done this year.

We trust that all participants will understand why the postponement until 2022 is necessary and promise to do everything we can to ensure that this event will be the highlight of 2022.

If circumstances allow we hope to be able to organize at relatively short notice a Fly-In in the autumn of this year. We are thinking in terms of a Gourmet-Event at Lake Constance, in Öhningen-Wangen. The destination airport would be Donaueschingen.


There are a number of very pleasant hotels available there, directly on the lakeside.


The exclusive Falconera restaurant is highly recommended, as is the Restaurant Rheinfels, right beside the Rhine in Stein am Rhein, etc., etc.
